

Photographing Wild Costa Rica

Capture Images of Iridescent Birds, Intriguing Mammals, Mist-Veiled Mountains & More!



Secluded in the tropical wilderness, our small group of photographers is one with the verdant landscape. We wait in silence in the cloud forest and train a keen eye high in the trees, looking for brilliant specimens of Costa Rica's hundreds of beautiful bird species. Our ultimate quest is the resplendent quetzal, sacred to the indigenous people of these remote mountains. Keep watch for sloths and monkeys, as we listen to nature's chirps, caws and calls. All around us, bright bromeliads, orchids and ancient oaks provide enticing subjects, too. Descending from the cloud-swathed Talamanca range to the rain forest of Sarapiquí, embark on a river cruise revealing crocodiles, frogs and myriad jungle wildlife. For nature photographers, Costa Rica is *Pura Vida!*

- » Photograph a wide array of exotic tropical birds, from brilliant hummingbirds to coveted finds like the resplendent quetzal and great green macaw
- » Capture photos of jungle wildlife—sloth, tapir, peccary, agouti, coati, monkeys and more—on guided nature walks and a private boat cruise on the Sarapiquí River
- » Visit world-famous La Selva research station to learn about conservation from scientists and explore the rain forest on a naturalist-guided photo adventure
