- » Daily excursions by Polar Rover over the tundra and along the coast reveal the nature and wildlife of the Canadian Northland



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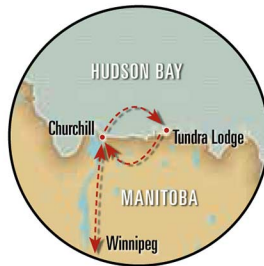
