Uluru, the true Aboriginal name for what many people know as **Ayers Rock**, rises from the broad desert plain in the deep centre of Australia and it's one of the country's most recognisable natural icon. The famous "Rock" stands 348 metres high and is located 440 kilometres south-west of Alice Springs in the Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park. Forty kilometres to the west of Uluru is Kata Tjuta, also known as The Olgas. This massive pile of rock domes dates back 500 million years. Both Uluru and Kata Tjuta have great Aboriginal cultural significance for the Anangu traditional landowners. Learn about the local flora and fauna, bush foods and the Aboriginal Dreamtime stories of the area.

Tuesday, October 16, 2018

This morning, you will meet your driver in the lobby of your hotel for your private tour of the Outback!

Revel in the early morning serenity of a truly spiritual place as the sunrise colours change on Kata Tjuta. Departing the resort your tour will travel through the landscape to the entrance of Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park. From there it's a 40 kilometre journey through the desert landscape to the mighty rock formation. On arrival at the viewing area you walk to the best vantage point to see the 36 domes that

comprise this spiritual place while watching the sun's morning glow as the desert comes alive. Make your way to the western side of Kata Tjuta where you will have the opportunity to relax and enjoy a gourmet picnic breakfast. As you approach the entrance to Walpa Gorge, named for the wind (Walpa) that whistles between the massive domes that shape Kata Tjuta, the result of eons of weathering and continual upheaval, your guide will share the significance of this men's sacred ceremonial site.

Your tour will travel through the landscapes to the entrance of the Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park. From this point it's a matter of minutes before the spectra of Uluru rises from the sand dunes to demonstrate its enormity and presence. With Uluru looming in front of you, the closer you get the more you surrender to the realisation of the sheer size of this monolith. As you drive around the base, your guide will take you to the entrance of Mutitjulu Waterhole, a semi-permanent watercourse nestled in the contours of Uluru. Here you will learn the creation stories of Liru (poisonous snake) and Kuniya (python) and their battle for control of Uluru as well as a number of other stories associated with other prominent Tjukurpa (Dreaming) stories. See the rock art of the ancients and learn how Uluru was, and still is, a significant location for teaching young Aboriginal people. Adjourn to the new Talinguru Nyakunytjaku viewing area for an uninterrupted view of Uluru with Kata Tjuta in the background. Your guide will then return to your accommodation at Ayers Rock Resort.

Sunday, 21 October 2018

Enjoy a guided walk through the Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserve with a Maori guide. There will be stops along the way to view points of interest such as bubbling mud pools, mineral springs, silica formations and shooting geysers and an opportunity to visit the Kiwi House where you may see the nocturnal Kiwi, New Zealand's national bird. On returning to the model village its various features will be explained to you before taking a look through the Maori Arts and Crafts Institute which gives an insight into Maori carving, customs and history.

Sculptured out of volcanic activity and thousands of years in the making, Wai-O-Tapu is considered to be New Zealand's most colourful and diverse geothermal sightseeing attraction. This is a uniquely different natural landscape and the key to what visitors see lies below the surface; one of the most extensive geothermal systems in New Zealand. Clearly defined tracks provide the opportunity to enjoy the diversity of this area through a series of different walks taking from 30 to 75 minutes or more, each with their own unique volcanic vistas to fascinate all ages.

The rest of the day is at leisure to visit Rotorua and its region on your own – you may want to take a drive to the redwood forest and further along to the Blue and Green lakes.

Think stunning scenery, waterfalls, rare birdlife and giant 1000-year old trees. This walk is regarded by NZ hikers as one of New Zealand's best one-day walks. Walk is 9km, approximately 4 hours hiking time. (lunch included. Please bring along sensible shoes, a warm jumper, a raincoat.)

Tuesday, October 23, 2018

This morning, you will drive to Rotorua airport to drop off your car and board your flight.

From alpine lakes, and raging rivers, to wide sandy coastlines surrounded by fertile countryside providing berries, olives, apples, pears and grapes, you just need to pick your path through rolling hills and coastal landscapes and choose between visiting gourmet food producers, boutique wineries and

breweries, the studios of a local artist or taking a walk in one of the stunning three National Parks. Nelson is also a vibrant coastal town full of bustling cafes, charming boutiques and funky art galleries, waiting to be leisurely explored. This is the place to forget about the busy pace of life for a while!

The vessel's shallow draughts allow it to be taken close to the shore, giving an excellent view of dozens of sandy coves as your guide shares the history of the area and highlights points of interest.

Enjoy today at your leisure exploring Nelson.

Friday, October 26, 2018

Today, you will drive to the West Coast via the Buller Gorge, Westport and finally Punakaiki (4 hours)

Forty three kilometres north of Greymouth, in Punakaiki, you will find an outstanding natural attraction known as the Pancake Rocks, consisting of eroded limestone rocks which have the appearance of a pile of pancakes. It is an easy walk from the road through attractive bush before reaching the rocks and the associated blowholes. There is a very good view of the coast from the rocks, and with a westerly gale blowing, the sight is spectacular!

Franz Josef Glacier area has some of the most spectacular scenery in New Zealand. Just six kilometres from the centre of the village, Franz Josef Glacier/Kā Roimata o Hine Hukatere descends from the tops of the Southern Alps/Kā Tiritiri o te Moana into rainforest close to sea level. This provides a very rare opportunity to experience a dynamic glacier in a temperate environment, within easy driving and walking distance from the main highway. Franz Josef is the name of both the glacier and the nearby village, though the Maori names are different. The small but lively Franz Josef Waiau village is surrounded by lush rainforest with the high snow-capped Alps above.

Take an optional helicopter flight to the Glacier or the short drive to its twin glacier Fox Glacier, just a 20min drive south. At Fox Glacier, on a fine day, you may wish to visit Lake Matheson. Lake Matheson is nestled in ancient forest and is famous for mirror views of Aoraki/Mount Cook and Mount Tasman. It's excellent mirror-like reflecting properties are due to the dark brown colour of the water.

Monday, October 29, 2018

Today, drive further along the West Coast to Lake Moeraki (1.5 hour)

This is one of the most scenic drives of your trip. The roads winds its way between the rugged coastline and the rainforest and offers fantastic panoramas.

In front of the Lodge there is a fleet of canoes for you to explore the Moeraki river and you can paddle the short distance up the river to the Lake.



Wednesday, October 31, 2018

Today, you will drive to Te Anau (5 hours).

From Lake Moeraki, the road sharply turns inland and through Haast pass to a mighty valley and the beautiful Mt Aspiring National Park. You can stop along the way for short walks. The National Park is lush and green, rivers, thick rainforest and waterfall alternate until you climb out towards Wanaka. This is now the last stretch of your journey as you go along Lake Hayes then lake Wanaka, the landscapes dries out and become more mountainous until your reach Queenstown. You finally follow the shore of Lake Wakatipu to Te Anau.

The name Te Anau is probably more correctly rendered in its original Maori form - Te Ana-au - which means 'Cave of the Swirling Water'. Te Anau is now a major resort area in the Fiordland/Southern Lakes district and is situated on the shore of the South Island's largest lake of the same name.

Today, you will drive to Milford Sound where you will board the Milford Wanderer and enjoy an overnight cruise. (2 hour drive)

Real Journeys, Queenstown

Milford Wanderer Overnight Cruise - 1 Double

Drive along the spectacular alpine route of the Milford Road, considered one of the most beautiful drives in the world. Upon arrival at Milford Sound, you will board the Milford Wanderer.

Departing from the Milford Wharf, the Milford Wanderer cruises the full length of Milford Sound to the Tasman Sea. A Nature Guide with specialist knowledge of the region's history, flora and fauna provides detailed commentary. There is plenty of time available to explore points of interest and view the spectacular alpine scenery including waterfalls, rainforest and the towering peaks. Keep a look out for wildlife including seals, dolphins and penguins when in season. After reaching the open sea, the sails may be hoisted subject to weather and conditions. The vessel then returns to the fiord and anchors overnight in sheltered Harrison Cove. Inclusions: Hotel pick up and drop off, dinner and breakfast. Overnight accommodation is in cabins with shared bathroom facilities. Enjoy a three-course dinner.

What to bring: Comfortable shoes, waterproof jacket, warm clothing, swimwear and insect repellent.

Saturday, November 3, 2018

The following morning, there are cooked and continental breakfast options available. There is time for further cruising on the fiord before returning to the Milford Wharf. After disembarking, drive to Queenstown (4 hours).

The internationally famous resort of Queenstown rests beside Lake Wakatipu at the foot of the Remarkable Ranges. Swathes of forest decorate the area between town and mountaintop. A more scenic location would be difficult to find. Queenstown is treasured for its ability to provide year-round outdoor entertainment. Queenstown is renowned for its shopping, dining and nightlife.
